Refugees, homeless, handicapped, orphans, elderly, the poor. We know them by their needs. What if we knew them by name?

Imagine a drop of water falling on a thirsty city. Now imagine pools of water, drops becoming ripples, ripples becoming waves, thirst quenched.

What if by serving others we could let people in need know that someone cared? What if for one week, everywhere you turned in the city, someone was serving someone else?

What: Our projects will include serving local associations, agencies, and churches that are working with people in need through sports, music, friendship, practical work, etc... We will divide up into groups of different sizes and spread-out to the various pre-arranged projects all over the city. There will be evening activities for the community and the volunteers as well.

Orientation will be conducted 2-3 July, actual service project participation will occur Monday through Saturday, 4-9 July.

Who: All youth 16 + (unless accompanied by a parent) and adults

Accommodations: Will stay at the Maguire farm (options to sleep in the barn or in the house)

Transportation to event sites: a combination of public and private transportation will be provided

Arrival: anytime on 1 July (or prior to 4 July. Abbreviated participation is possible- please indicate time of arrival on your registration itinerary:http://www.tec-europe.org/YAE/YAE_eventforms.htm#STCBelgium)

Cost: 240 euro per participant (20 euro a day for meals (3) and transportation and accommodations. May be adjusted according to participation.)
